Donating blood is a safe process and the Red Cross has implemented additional precautionary measures to help ensure donor, staff and volunteer safety during this challenging time. U.S. health officials have also urged donors to come give blood as a critical and safe thing to do now.

As of Tuesday, March 17 nearly 4,000 Red Cross blood drives had been canceled across the country as high schools, colleges, businesses and other organizations temporarily close and more people are told to work remotely. This has already resulted in more than 100,000 fewer blood donations, and that number continues to grow.

Without enough blood on the shelves, hospitals may have to delay essential and lifesaving surgeries for patients of all ages. As a nation, we must come together to take care of one another, especially those most vulnerable among us.
